

At Seton Catholic High School we believe that student activities outside the classroom are a vital part of a student's education. Extracurricular activities foster growth and development as a well-rounded young person. Many of our students participate in Student Government (commonly referred to as Student Council), National Honor Society, and Athletics.

Student Government – Seniors fill officer positions that include: President, Vice President, Treasurer, and Secretary. Elections are held in early fall, candidates prepare speeches, and the entire student body votes. Three representatives are selected from each grade level to represent their class. Student Government will often be involved in outreach drives and collections, leads our Blood Drive efforts, and organizes dances, lock-in's and other student activities.

National Honor Society – National Honor Society inductions take place in the spring. Students in grades 11 and 12 meeting the xxx GPA, and who are in good standing with the school may apply. National Honor Society provides peer tutoring to students in grades 7-12 throughout the year, and is responsible for hosting the annual Daddy-Daughter Dance for grades PS -6.
